TUL's privacy policy covers the collection and use of personal information that may be collected by TUL anytime you interact with TUL. Please take a moment to read the following to learn more about our information practices, including what type of information is gathered, how the information is used and for what purposes, to whom we disclose the information, and how we safeguard your personal information.

Why we collect personal information

Why do we collect your personal information? Because it helps us deliver a superior level of customer service. Your personal information may help us keep you posted on the latest product announcements, software updates, special offers, and events that you might like to hear about.

What information we collect

There are a number of situations in which your personal information may help us give you better service. For example, we may ask for your personal information when you're downloading a software update, registering for a seminar, participating in an online survey. At such times, we may collect personal information relevant to the situation, such as your name, mailing address, phone number, email address, and contact preferences. We collect information for market research purposes - such as your occupation and where you use your computer - to gain a better understanding of our customers and thus provide more valuable service. We also collect information regarding customer activities on our website. This helps us to determine how best to provide useful information to customers and to understand which parts of our websites and Internet services are of most interest to them.

If you use a bulletin board or chat room on a TUL website you should be aware that any information you share is visible to other users. Personally identifiable information you submit to one of these forums can be read, collected, or used by other individuals to send you unsolicited messages. TUL is not responsible for the personally identifiable information you choose to submit in these forums.

When we disclose your information

TUL takes your privacy very seriously. Be assured that TUL does not sell or rent your contact information to other marketers. To help us provide superior service, your personal information may be shared with legal entities within the TUL group globally who will safeguard it in accordance with TUL's privacy policy. There are also times when it may be advantageous for TUL to make certain personal information about you available to companies that TUL has a strategic relationship with or that perform work for TUL to provide products and services to you on our behalf. These companies are also obligated to protect your personal information in accordance with TUL's policies. At times we may be required by law or litigation to disclose your personal information. We may also disclose information about you if we determine that for national security, law enforcement, or other issues of public importance, disclosure is necessary.



How we protect your personal information

TUL will use every reasonable commercial effort to take precautions - including administrative, technical, and physical measures - to safeguard your personal information against loss, theft, and misuse, as well as unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, and destruction.

You can help us by also taking precautions to protect your personal data when you are on the Internet. Change your passwords often using a combination of letters and numbers, and make sure you use a secure web browser.

Integrity of your personal information

TUL has safeguards in place to keep your personal information accurate, complete, and up to date for the purposes for which it is used. Naturally, you always have the right to access and correct the personal information you have provided. You can help us ensure that your contact information and preferences are accurate, complete, and up to date by checking at www.TUL.com.tw.

Use of Cookies

Cookies are small files which many web sites transfer to your hard disk. They can inform the web site what pages you visit, and your preferences, which enable web sites to provide you with a more personalized service. You can set your browser to refuse cookies, or to warn you before accepting them.

We use cookies, but most parts of our site can be accessed even if your cookies are turned off. But you may find there are parts of the site which you cannot access if your cookies are turned off.

Our companywide commitment to your privacy

As we said, TUL takes protecting your privacy very seriously. To make sure your personal information is secure, we communicate these guidelines to TUL employees and strictly enforce privacy safeguards within the company. A number of other people's web sites have links on our site. If you link to their sites, they may collect information. Such sites are not within our control and are not covered by this privacy statement. We encourage you to learn about the privacy policies of those companies.

TUL may, at its discretion, update its privacy policy from time to time. When we change the policy in a material way, a notice will be posted on our website along with the updated privacy policy.
